## Rippled Afghan

A fast and easy crochet afghan.

Uses Knitting Worsted Yarn

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## MATERIALS

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Knitting Worsted 100g ball

2 of each of 4 colours = 8 balls

Sizes 7mm (U.S. K) crochet hook or size needed to obtain tension.

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## TENSION

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Size: Approximately 45" x 60"

3 sts = 1 inch with 7mm crochet hook

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## INSTRUCTIONS

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*Note: Always work in BACK LOOP of sts, EXCEPT first and last 2 sts to prevent edges from curling.*

### Striping Pattern

\* 4 rows each colours A, B, C, and D.

Repeat from \* for striping pattern.

Using colour A, ch 189 sts.

**Row 1:** 2 s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in next st, skip next st, \* working in BACK LOOP ONLY, 1 s c in each of the next 10 sts, 3 s c in next st, 1 s c in each of the next 10 sts, skip next 2 sts, repeat from \* 7 times more, ending last repeat skip next st, 1 s c in each of the last 2 sts, ch 1, turn.

**Rows 2, 3, and 4:** 1 s c in each of the next 2 sts, skip 1 st, \* working in BACK LOOP ONLY, 1 s c in each of the next 10 sts, 3 s c in next st, 1 s c in each of the next 10 sts, skip 2 sts, repeat from \* 7 times more, ending last repeat skip 1 st, 1 s c in each of the last 2 sts, ch 1, turn.

Continue to work in this manner, until there are 8 complete colour patterns, ending with 4 rows colour A.

Fasten off. Steam lightly.
